her own experiences and founded Devotion to Children in 1994; the organization works with businesses,

 17 computer labs, library programs, child-care scholarships, emergency child-care funding, and preschool

20 Awards program in New Orleans on November 8, 2014, where she received \$10,000 for Devotion to
