5 6 WHEREAS, the Honorable William Wellington Jones, a distinguished attorney, highly admired 7 former judge of the 5th Judicial District of Virginia, and active member of the Suffolk and Nansemond County communities, died on January 25, 2015; and 8

WHEREAS, a native of Driver, William Jones graduated from Chuckatuck High School and earned bachelor's and law degrees from The College of William and Mary; he also served his country as a 9 10 member of the United States Navy, achieving the rank of lieutenant; and 11

WHEREAS, beginning in 1947, William Jones practiced law in Suffolk; he became a judge in 12 13 Nansemond County in 1949, then became the Commonwealth's Attorney of Nansemond County in 1954; 14 and

WHEREAS, William Jones was appointed as a judge of the Suffolk General District Court of the 5th 15 Judicial District of Virginia in 1978; he presided with great fairness and wisdom until his well-earned 16 retirement from the bench in 1991; and 17

WHEREAS, during his tenure as a judge, William Jones was respected for his knowledge of the law 18 19 and commitment to justice; and

20 WHEREAS, William Jones also worked to enhance the quality of life of his fellow residents as a 21 member of American Legion Post 57, the Driver Ruritan Club, and the local Lions Club; and

22 WHEREAS, William Jones was proud of his family's heritage in the region; he was a member of the 23 Sons of Confederate Veterans and a charter member and president of the Suffolk-Nansemond Historical 24 Society: and

25 WHEREAS, a man of great integrity, William Jones served the Commonwealth with the utmost 26 professionalism, dedication, and distinction; he will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by 27 numerous family members and friends; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring. That the General Assembly hereby 28 29 note with great sadness the loss of the Honorable William Wellington Jones, a respected judge and 30 admired member of the Suffolk and Nansemond County communities; and, be it
