WHEREAS, Steve Calos returned to the Commonwealth as a public information officer in
 Richmond; he later became the executive director of Common Cause Virginia, where he successfully
 advocated for various issues related to the public good; and

WHEREAS, Steve Calos also founded and chaired the Virginia Network for Campaign Finance
 Reform and served as executive director of the Virginia Association of Soil and Water Conservation
 Districts; and

WHEREAS, generously volunteering his time and talents to enhance the community, Steve Calos
helped establish and led Boy Scout Troop 498, which has been named one of the top Catholic-sponsored
troops in the nation, and served as the president of the Forest Hills Neighborhood Association; and

WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith who was proud of his Greek heritage, Steve Calos
 enjoyed fellowship and worship as a member of Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church,
 serving on the parish council; and

WHEREAS, Steve Calos will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by numerous family
 members, friends, and colleagues; now, therefore, be it
