Commending the winners of the Pete Shepherd Volunteer Public Water Access Service Award.

WHEREAS, the winners of the inaugural Pete Shepherd Volunteer Public Water Access Service Award have donated their time and talents to ensure that Perrin Wharf in Gloucester County remains clean and presentable as a commercial seafood wharf and public access site; now, therefore, be it
