WHEREAS, a lifelong rail enthusiast, David Helmer applied for a job at Norfolk and Western
 Railway; he worked his way up to become director of the costs section at Norfolk Southern in Roanoke;

17 former president and director of the board of the Historical Society of Western Virginia; he also helped
18 establish the O. Winston Link Museum and served on the advisory committee; and

20 Helmer was active with the Roanoke Kiwanis Club, North Cross School, and many other civic and
21 service organizations; and

WHEREAS, David Helmer will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by numerous family
