10 11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	<b>1.</b> § 1. That the Department of Medical Assistance Services shall amend eligibility criteria for the
13	Intellectual Disability waiver and the Individual and Family Developmental Disabilities Support waiver
14	to allow the dependent of an active duty member of the military who was added to the waiting list for
15 16	services through the Intellectual Disability waiver or the Individual and Family Developmental Disabilities Support waiver while he was a resident of the Commonwealth to maintain his position on
17	the waiting list following a transfer of the active duty military member to an assignment outside of the
18	Commonwealth, so long as the active duty military member maintains the Commonwealth as his legal
19	residence to which he intends to return following completion of military service. In cases in which the
20	dependent becomes eligible for services through the Intellectual Disability waiver or the Individual and
21	Family Developmental Disabilities Support waiver prior to returning to the Commonwealth, the

individual shall remain on the waiting list for services and shall be eligible for the next waiver slot to
become available upon his return to the Commonwealth.
