SENATE BILL NO. 1066

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Joint Conference Committee

on February 26, 2015)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Obenshain)

- A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 24.2-200, 24.2-207, 24.2-209, and 24.2-682 of the Code of Virginia, relating to vacancies in elected offices; term of office; special elections.
 - Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 9 1. That §§ 24.2-200, 24.2-207, 24.2-209, and 24.2-682 of the Code of Virginia are amended and 10 reenacted as follows: 11

§ 24.2-200. When terms to begin.

12 A. The terms of all officers chosen at a November general election shall begin on the January 1 13 succeeding their election unless otherwise provided in this chapter. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the terms of all officers elected at a May general election shall begin on the July 1 succeeding 14 15 their election. They shall continue to discharge the duties of their respective offices until their successors 16 qualify.

17 B. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection A, if the office filled at the November or May 18 general election is vacant, then the term of office for the officer chosen at the November or May election shall begin when the officer has qualified and taken the oath of office. 19 20

§ 24.2-207. Filling vacancies in Senate.

21 When any vacancy occurs in the representation of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the United 22 States Senate, the Governor shall issue a writ of election to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the 23 unexpired term. The election shall be held on the next succeeding November general election date or, if 24 the vacancy occurs within 120 days prior to that date, on the second succeeding November general 25 election date. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no election to fill a vacancy shall be ordered or held if the general or special election at which it is to be called is scheduled within 75 26 27 days of the end of the term of the office to be filled. The Governor may make a temporary appointment 28 to fill the vacancy until the qualified voters fill the same by election. 29

§ 24.2-209. Filling vacancies in House of Representatives.

30 When any vacancy occurs in the representation of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the House of 31 Representatives, or when a representative-elect dies or resigns, the Governor shall issue a writ of 32 election to fill the vacancy. Upon receipt of written notification by a representative or 33 representative-elect of his resignation as of a stated date, the Governor may immediately issue a writ to 34 call the election. The representative's or representative-elect's resignation shall not be revocable after the 35 date stated by him for his resignation or after the forty-fifth day before the date set for the special 36 election. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no election to fill a vacancy shall be 37 ordered or held if the general or special election at which it is to be called is scheduled within 75 days 38 of the end of the term of the office to be filled. 39

§ 24.2-682. Times for special elections.

40 A. Notwithstanding any charter or special act to the contrary, the following provisions govern the 41 times for holding special elections. Every special election shall be held on a Tuesday. No special election shall be held within the 55 days prior to a general or primary election. No special election shall 42 be held on the same day as a primary election. A special election may be held on the same day as a 43 44 general election. No special election to fill a vacancy in an office shall be held on the same day as the 45 general election at which that office is regularly scheduled to be filled.

46 B. A referendum election shall be ordered at least 81 days prior to the date for which the referendum 47 election is called.

48 C. A special election to fill a vacancy in any constitutional office shall be held promptly and in 49 accordance with the requirements of subsection A.
