15104089D **SENATE BILL NO. 1105** 1 2 3 4 5 6 AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE (Proposed by the Senate Committee on Education and Health on January 22, 2015) (Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Miller) A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 14 of Title 22.1 a section 7 numbered 22.1-275.2, relating to the School Health Advisory Board. 8 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 9 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 14 of Title 22.1 a section numbered 22.1-275.2 as follows: 10 § 22.1-275.2. School Health Advisory Board. 11 A. The School Health Advisory Board (the Board) is established as an advisory board, within the 12 13 meaning of § 2.2-2100, in the executive branch of state government. The purpose of the Board shall be 14 to advise the General Assembly on pending legislation concerning health policy that affects elementary 15 and secondary schools. 16 B. The Board shall consist of 10 nonlegislative citizen members and two ex officio members as 17 follows: four nonlegislative citizen members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates; two 18 nonlegislative citizen members appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules; four nonlegislative citizen members appointed by the Governor; and the Secretary of Education, or his designee, and the Secretary 19 20 of Health and Human Resources, or his designee, who shall serve ex officio with voting privileges. 21 C. Nonlegislative citizen members appointed by the Governor shall serve for terms of four years, and 22 nonlegislative citizen members appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules and the Speaker of the 23 House of Delegates shall serve for terms of two years. The Secretary of Education and the Secretary of 24 Health and Human Resources, or their designees, shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office. 25 Vacancies occurring other than by expiration of a term shall be filled for the unexpired term. Vacancies 26 shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments. Any nonlegislative citizen member may 27 be reappointed for successive terms. 28 D. The members of the Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman annually from among its 29 membership. The Board shall meet at such times as it deems appropriate or on call of the chairman. A 30 majority of the members of the Board shall constitute a quorum. E. Members shall receive no compensation for their services. However, all members shall be 31 32 reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as 33 provided in §§ 2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825. Funding for the costs of expenses of the members shall be 34 provided by the Department of Education. 35 F. The Department of Education shall provide staff support to the Board. 36 G. The chairman of the Board shall submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an annual

executive summary of the interim activity and work of the Board no later than the first day of each
regular session of the General Assembly. The executive summary shall be submitted as provided in the
procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents
and reports and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website.

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
