9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 52-8.6 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 52-8.6. Criminal street gang reporting.
13	When it is determined, by a state or local law-enforcement agency, regional jail, the Department of
14	Corrections, the Department of Juvenile Justice, or a regional multijurisdictional law-enforcement task
15	force, that a person is a member of a criminal street gang, as defined in § 18.2-46.1 by means of (i) an
16	admission of membership in a gang; (ii) an observation by a law-enforcement officer that a person
17	frequents a known gang area, associates with known gang members and demonstrates gang style of
18	dress, tattoos, hand signals, or symbols; or (iii) being arrested on more than one occasion with known
19	gang members for offenses consistent with gang activities, the agency shall enter the person's name and
20	other appropriate gang-related information required by the Department of State Police into the
21	information system known as the Organized Criminal Gang File of the Virginia Criminal Information
22	Network (VCIN), established and maintained by the Department pursuant to Chapter 2 (§ 52-12 et seq.)
23 24	of this title, and the Violent Criminal Gang File of the National Crime Information Center (NCIC),
24 25	maintained by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The entry shall be made as soon as practicable after determining that a person is a member of an organized criminal gang; <i>however</i> , <i>if the person is</i>
25 26	incarcerated in the Department of Corrections and his period of incarceration exceeds one year, the
27	entry may be made at any time prior to the person's release from incarceration. All records contained in
28	these information systems shall be entered, retained, and validated in accordance with established VCIN

29 and NCIC policies.
