13	The provisions of this article shall not apply to:
14	1. The sale of secondhand material mentioned in § 59.1-117 taken from premises occupied by the
15	owner, when sold by such owner on the premises, or the sale of such articles when purchased from a
16	public utility corporation at its place of business or a governmental agency;
17	2. Scrap metal purchasers as provided in Article 4 (§ 59.1-136.1 et seq.);
18	3. Authorized scrap sellers;
19	4. Public utilities;
20	5. Public transportation companies;
21	6. Peddlers permitted under § 59.1-118;
22	7. Industrial and manufacturing companies;
23	8. Marine, automobile, and aircraft salvage and wrecking companies; of
24	9. Governmental entities; or
25	10. The donation of secondhand material mentioned in § 59.1-117 by the material's owner or the
<b>26</b>	owner's contractor or subcontractor to a nonprofit corporation as defined in § $501(c)(3)$ of the U.S.
