That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 1 of Title 23 a section numbered 10 11 23-9.2:15 as follows: § 23-9.2:15. Sexual assault; memorandum of understanding; policies. 12 13 A. The governing board of each public or private institution of higher education shall establish and 14 the State Board for Community Colleges shall adopt a policy requiring each community college to 15 establish a written memorandum of understanding with a local sexual assault crisis center or other victim support service in order to provide sexual assault victims with immediate access to a confidential, 16 17 independent advocate who can provide a trauma-informed response that includes an explanation of 18 options for counseling and the different disciplinary and law-enforcement investigations that may be 19 initiated by the victim. 20 B. The governing board of each public or private institution of higher education shall adopt policies 21 that require the institution to offer to refer a sexual assault victim to the sexual assault crisis center or 22 other victim support service, encourage victims to undergo a sexual assault examination to preserve 23 physical evidence, provide clear guidance on linking victims to other community resources, provide 24 options for victims who do not want to make an official report to make an anonymous report to the 25 institution, and provide for nonretaliation by the institution against victims who fear their conduct may 26 also be questioned or who are concerned that an official report might jeopardize their academic status. 27 C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the institution from offering its own support 28 services to the victim or to require a sexual assault victim to take any action against such victim's 29 wishes. 30 D. This section shall not apply to proprietary institutions as defined in § 23-276.1.
