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## **SENATE BILL NO. 1341**

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

on February 5, 2015)

3 4 5 6 A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 62.1-256.1, relating to 7 establishment of the Eastern Virginia Groundwater Management Advisory Committee. 8 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

9 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 62.1-256.1 as follows:

10 § 62.1-256.1. Eastern Virginia Groundwater Management Advisory Committee established.

11 A. The Eastern Virginia Groundwater Management Advisory Committee (the Committee) is hereby established as an advisory committee to assist the State Water Commission and the Department of 12 Environmental Quality in developing, revising, and implementing a management strategy for ground 13 water in the Eastern Virginia Groundwater Management Area. The Committee shall be appointed by the 14 15 Director of the Department of Environmental Quality and shall be composed of nonlegislative citizen 16 members consisting of representatives of industrial and municipal water users; representatives of public 17 and private water providers; developers and representatives from the economic development community; representatives of agricultural, conservation, and environmental organizations; state and federal 18 agencies officials; and university faculty and citizens with expertise in water resources-related issues. 19 20 The Committee shall meet at least four times each calendar year.

21 Members of the Committee shall receive no compensation for their service and shall not be entitled 22 to reimbursement for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

23 B. The Committee shall examine (i) options for developing a long-term alternative water sources, 24 including water reclamation and reuse, ground water recharge, desalination, and surface water options, 25 including creation of storage reservoirs; (ii) the interaction between the Department of Environmental Quality's ground water management programs and local and regional water supply plans within the 26 27 Eastern Virginia Groundwater Management Area for purposes of determining water demand and 28 possible solutions for meeting that demand; (iii) potential funding options both for study and for 29 implementation of management options; (iv) alternative management structures, such as a water resource trading program, formation of a long-term ground water management committee, and 30 formation of a commission; (v) additional data needed to more fully assess aquifer health and 31 32 sustainable ground water management strategies; (vi) potential future ground water permitting criteria; 33 and (vii) other policies and procedures that the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality 34 determines may enhance the effectiveness of ground water management in the Eastern Virginia 35 Groundwater Management Area. The Committee shall develop specific statutory, budgetary, and 36 regulatory recommendations, as necessary, to implement its recommendations.

37 C. The Committee shall report the results of its examination and related recommendations to the 38 State Water Commission and the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality no later than 39 August 1, 2017. The Director of the Department of Environmental Quality shall issue a report responding to the Committee's recommendations to the Governor, the State Water Commission, the 40 41 Chairman of the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources, the Chairman 42 of the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources, and the Joint Legislative 43 Audit and Review Commission no later than November 1, 2017.

2. That the provisions of this act shall expire on January 1, 2018. 44

3. That unless otherwise agreed to by a ground water management permittee, the State Water 45 Control Board and the Department of Environmental Quality shall not issue draft permits that 46

47 would require reductions in permitted volumes of ground water withdrawals prior to December
