That § 58.1-3831 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 58.1-3831. Tax in certain counties. A. Fairfax and Arlington, Fairfax, Montgomery, and Pulaski Counties shall have the power to levy 11 tax upon the sale or use of cigarettes. Such tax shall be in such amount and on such terms as the 12 governing body may by ordinances prescribe, not to exceed five cents per pack or the amount levied 13 under state law, whichever is greater. The provisions of § 58.1-3830 shall apply to such counties, 14 15 mutatis mutandis. 16 B. The revenues generated from the tax imposed pursuant to this section in Montgomery and Pulaski 17 Counties shall be used solely for public education, including but not limited to, school construction. 2. That Montgomery County and Pulaski County shall expend or disburse for public education 18 purposes each year after imposition of the tax pursuant to this act, an amount that is at least 19 20 equal to the average annual amount expended or disbursed for public education purposes by the county, excluding bond proceeds or debt service payments and federal or state funds, during the 21 36-month period immediately prior to the effective date of the imposition of such tax. 3. That the provisions of this act shall expire at midnight on June 30, 2025.
