

## 1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to allocate funding for the Hampton Roads Veterans Care Center project.*

4 Approved

5 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

6 **1.** § 1. *In order to expedite the completion of the Hampton Roads Veterans Care Center project, \$32.7*  
7 *million in Virginia Public Building Authority Bonds authorized in Item C-39.40 of Chapter 1 of the Acts*  
8 *of Assembly of 2014, Special Session I, shall be made available as a priority for the Hampton Roads*  
9 *Veterans Care Center project set forth in paragraph B of such Item. Upon certifications from the*  
10 *Virginia Department of Veterans Services to the State Treasurer and the Director of the Department of*  
11 *Planning and Budget that a federal grant or grants have been awarded for the Hampton Roads*  
12 *Veterans Care Center project, the Director of the Department of Planning and Budget shall allocate in*  
13 *bond proceeds up to the amounts provided above, and the same shall be appropriated, to the Virginia*  
14 *Department of Veterans Services so that the project or projects may proceed without further action by*  
15 *the Commonwealth, in accordance with 38 C.F.R. § 59.50 and 38 C.F.R. § 59.70(b).*

16 § 2. *In addition to such priority allocation of bonds under § 1, the General Assembly hereby*  
17 *appropriates \$60.7 million in nongeneral fund authority for federal grant funds to the Virginia*  
18 *Department of Veterans Services for the Hampton Roads Veterans Care Center project.*

19 § 3. *The Hampton Roads Veterans Care Center project is authorized up to a 230-bed facility.*
