9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 24.2-307.1 as follows:
12	§ 24.2-307.1. Requirements for county and city vote centers; pilot program.
13	A. For purposes of this section, "vote center" means any structure that contains a place provided for
14	two or more designated precincts at which the qualified voters who are residents of the designated
15	precincts may be directed to vote.
16	B. The State Board shall be authorized to establish pilot programs in one or more localities
17	authorizing the use of vote centers in primary elections, in order to study the efficacy and cost savings
18	of vote centers in primary elections. The State Board shall promulgate guidelines for vote center
19	selection criteria and administrative procedures to be followed by any locality applying to participate in
20	the vote center pilot program.
21	C. The governing body of a locality applying to participate in the pilot program shall, subject to the
22	unanimous consent of the local electoral board, submit to the State Board a plan for the locality's
23	participation in the pilot program. Any such plan shall include the number of vote centers to be
24	established in the locality for use in a primary election and the location of each such vote center. The
25 26	governing body of any locality whose plan for participation in the vote center pilot program has been unanimously approved by the State Board shall establish by ordinance as many vote centers as it deems
20 27	necessary.
28	D. All provisions of this title governing polling places shall apply to vote centers unless otherwise
29	provided in this section.
