| 11 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 63.2-607.1 as follows: |
| 12 | § 63.2-607.1. Eligibility for TANF; drug-related felonies. |
| 13 | A person who is otherwise eligible to receive TANF assistance shall be exempt from the application |
| 14 | of § 115(a)(1) of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, P.L. |
| 15 | 104-193, and shall not be denied such assistance solely because he has been convicted of a felony |
| 16 | offense of possession of a controlled substance in violation of § 18.2-250, provided such person (i) is |
| 17 | not engaged in the use of illegal drugs and complies with, or has already complied with, all obligations |
| 18 | imposed by the criminal court and the Department; (ii) is actively engaged in or has completed a |
| 19 | substance abuse treatment program; and (iii) participates in drug screenings conducted at least once |
| 20 | every three months, or more frequently if there is reason to believe the individual may be engaged in |
| 21 | the use of illegal drugs. |
