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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 32.1-65 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 32.1-65. Certain newborn screening required.
13	In order to prevent intellectual disability and permanent disability or death, every infant who is born
14	in the Commonwealth shall be subjected to atscreening tests for various disorders consistent with, but
15	not necessarily identical to, the uniform condition panel recommended by the U.S. Secretary of Health
16	and Human Services and the Secretary's Advisory Committee on Heritable Disorders in Newborns and
17	Children. Such screening tests shall include a screening test for Krabbe disease and other lysosomal
18	storage disorders.
19	Any infant whose parent or guardian objects thereto on the grounds that such tests conflict with his
20	religious practices or tenets shall not be required to receive such screening tests.
21	The physician or certified nurse midwife in charge of the infant's care after delivery shall cause such
22	tests to be performed. The screening tests shall be performed by the Division of Consolidated
23	Laboratory Services or any other laboratory the Department of Health has contracted with to provide this
24	service.
