15	A. Every unlicensed and unregistered family day home shall, prior to beginning such operation and
16 17	annually thereafter, submit the following to the Commissioner: (i) a statement of intent to operate an unlicensed and unnegittened family day home serving forcer than six shildren, evolution of the provider's
17	unlicensed and unregistered family day home serving fewer than six children, exclusive of the provider's own children and any children who reside in the home; (ii) the name, address, and telephone number of
19	the person maintaining the family day home; and (iii) a statement that the person who maintains the
20	family day home has complied with all background check requirements listed in subsection B.
21	B. No unlicensed and unregistered family day home shall hire or employ any person who has an
22	offense as defined in § 63.2-1719 if such person will be involved in the day-to-day operations of the
