[Where registered mail or certified mail is required, proof of service shall also be 18 required by the third-party commercial carrier. ] Any applicable requirements in other titles of this 19 20 Code or the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia for proof of such service, delivery, or transmission 21 shall remain in effect when a third-party commercial carrier is used. 22 § 54.1-101.2.
