Celebrating the life of Major Michael Donahue, USA.

- WHEREAS, Major Donahue earned many awards and decorations, including the Bronze Star Medal,the Purple Heart, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, and the Meritorious Service Medal; and
- 18 WHÊREAS, Major Donahue made the ultimate sacrifice while serving with the XVIII Airborne19 Corps at a special operations base near Kabul, Afghanistan; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Major Donahue's sacrifice is a reminder of the many dangers faced by American men
 21 and women in uniform, whose dedication to duty and country places them in harm's way throughout the
 22 world; and
- WHEREAS, Major Donahue will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his wife, Sherri;
 children, Victoria, Seamus, and Bailey; and numerous other family members and friends; now, therefore,
 be it
- RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby
 note with great sadness the loss of Major Michael Donahue, USA, a dedicated educator and a respected
 member of the United States military; and, be it
