4	Endorsing the framework of the statewide strategic plan for higher education developed by the State
5	Council of Higher Education for Virginia as the Commonwealth's vision and plan for higher

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10	WHEREAS, pursuant to § 23-9.6:1 of the Code of Virginia, the State Council of Higher Education
12	for Virginia (Council or SCHEV) is charged with the development of a statewide strategic plan for
13	higher education that reflects the goals and objectives of the Virginia Higher Education Opportunity Act
14	(Top Jobs Act) and the Restructured Higher Education Financial and Administrative Operations Act
15	(Restructuring Act), identifies a coordinated approach to state and regional goals, and emphasizes the
16	future needs for higher education in the Commonwealth; and
17	WHEREAS, as the Commonwealth's coordinating agency, SCHEV is required to advocate for and
18	promote the operation of an educationally and economically sound, vigorous, progressive, and
19	coordinated system of higher education; lead state-level postsecondary strategic planning, policy
20	development, and implementation based on research and analysis; facilitate collaboration among
21	institutions of higher education to enhance quality and create operational efficiencies; and work with
22 23	institutions and governing boards on board development; and WHEREAS, in executing its charge, SCHEV has collaborated successfully with students and
23 24	families; institutions of higher education; the pre-kindergarten through grade 12 education system;
25	community organizations; local, regional, and state business leaders; and members and staff of the
2 6	legislative and executive branches and has reviewed relevant data, projections, and documents, including
27	the strategic plans of institutions of higher education, the six-year plans of public institutions of higher
28	education, and the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission's reports on public higher education
29	cost and efficiency in response to House Joint Resolution 108 (2012); and
30	WHEREAS, in fulfillment of its duty, the Council has approved a framework of mission, vision,
31	goals, and strategies for the statewide strategic plan for higher education in the Commonwealth that is
32	grounded in the Commonwealth's changing economy and demographics, its regional differences, and the
33	current and future needs of its citizens for postsecondary education and training; and
34	WHEREAS, within this planning framework, SCHEV has articulated a mission for higher education in the Commonwealth ("educated posterior research and public service that enhance the
35 36	in the Commonwealth ("advance postsecondary learning, research and public service that enhance the civic and financial health of the Commonwealth and the well-being of all its people"); expressed a
37	vision for higher education in the Commonwealth ("transform the lives of Virginians, our communities
38	and our Commonwealth"); set four overarching goals for higher education in the Commonwealth ("(i)
39	provide affordable access for all; (ii) optimize student success for work and life; (iii) drive change and
40	improvement through innovation and investment; and (iv) advance the economic and cultural prosperity
41	of the Commonwealth and its regions"); and offered multiple tactical strategies for achieving each goal;

43	WHEREAS, when uncertain state revenues and economic and technological disruption challenge the
44	diversity, quality, and value of higher education in the Commonwealth, the Commonwealth must make
45 46	strategic decisions guided by a shared vision and common goals; now, therefore, be it
46 47	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the framework of mission, vision, goals, and strategies for the statewide strategic plan for higher education developed and approved
4 7 48	by the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia be endorsed as the Commonwealth's vision and
49	plan for higher education; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That such framework shall serve to guide the planning and resource
allocation decisions of the General Assembly as the Commonwealth seeks to provide quality education
and in-demand skills for a changing populace, as well as opportunities for economic development and
growth; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the mission, vision, goals, and strategies expressed in the statewide
strategic plan framework also guide the development of the strategic plan and six-year plan at each
public institution of higher education, as well as the agency plan for SCHEV, and that SCHEV report
annually on the Commonwealth's progress toward achieving these goals and targets to the Governor,
General Assembly, institutions of higher education, and the public; and, be it

59 RESOLVED FINALLY, That the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia shall submit 60 annually to the Governor and the General Assembly an executive summary and a report of its findings 61 and recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive summary and 62 report shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated 63 Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports no later than the first day of each 64 Regular Session of the General Assembly for six years, beginning with the 2016 Session, and shall be 65 posted on the Virginia General Assembly's website.
