8	WHEREAS, the Honorable Dudley J. Emick, Jr., of Daleville, who represented the residents of the
9	Roanoke region in the House of Delegates and the Senate of Virginia and served as a judge of the
10	Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court of the 25th Judicial District of Virginia, died on October
11	25, 2014; and
12	WHEREAS, a native of Bartley, West Virginia, Dudley Emick was known to family and friends as
13	"Buzz"; he graduated from Jefferson Senior High School and earned a bachelor's degree from what is
14	now Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, where he was a member of the Reserve Officer
15	Training Corps; and
16	WHEREAS, Dudley Emick served his country in the United States Army as a second lieutenant with
17	the 69th Signal Battalion; after completing his military service, he earned a law degree from the
18 19	University of Richmond; and WHEPEAS Dudley Emister prostigad law with a firm in Einspetle for many years, desirous to be of
19 20	WHEREAS, Dudley Emick practiced law with a firm in Fincastle for many years; desirous to be of further service to the community and the Commonwealth, he ran for and was elected to the House of

22	WHEREAS, Dudley Emick was elected to the Senate of Virginia in 1975, and he ably represented
23	the residents of the 22nd District for 16 years; he supported and sponsored many important pieces of
24	legislation and offered his leadership and expertise to several committees; and
25	WHEREAS, in 1992, Dudley Emick was appointed as a judge of the Juvenile and Domestic
26	Relations District Court of the 25th Judicial District of Virginia, where he presided with great fairness
27 28	and wisdom until his retirement in 2005; and WHEREAS, Dudley Emick worked to enhance and strengthen the Botetourt County community; he
20 29	was a member of the local Lions Club and Jaycees and was active with the Lord Botetourt High School
30	football program; and
31	WHEREAS, a man of great integrity, Dudley Emick served the Roanoke Valley and the
32	Commonwealth with the utmost professionalism, dedication, and distinction; and
33	WHEREAS, Dudley Emick will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his wife of 53 years,
34	Martha; children, Mary, Dudley III, Margaret, and Laura, and their families; and numerous other family
35	members, friends, and colleagues on both sides of the aisle; now, therefore, be it
