5. Summary: Requires that appointments to the electoral board in a county or city be made by the senior judge of the judicial circuit for that county or city. Currently, such appointments are made by the senior judge only if a majority of the circuit judges of the judicial circuit cannot agree on an appointment.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Elections, House Bill 1292 does not have a state fiscal impact. The proposed legislation amends § 15.2-3543, Code of Virginia, to allow the senior judge to appointment members of the electoral board in lieu of a majority of the circuit judges.
