4. Title: Applications for absentee ballots; photo identification required.

5. Summary: Requires that any voter submitting his application for an absentee ballot by mail or by electronic or telephonic transmission to a facsimile device shall submit with his application a copy of one of the forms of identification acceptable under current law. Currently, only a voter who completes his application for an absentee ballot in person is required to show a form of identification.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Elections, House Bill 1318 does not have a state fiscal impact. The proposed legislation amends subsection B 2. of § 24.2-701, Code of Virginia, to require a voter who submits their absentee ballot application either through mail, e-mail, or fax, to also include a copy of one of the forms of identification specified in subsection B of § 24.2-643, Code of Virginia.
