4. Title: Industrial waste; land application unlawful in certain counties.

5. Summary: Makes it unlawful to apply industrial wastes to land located in the County of Hanover, King William, or New Kent. This bill also contains an emergency clause.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Environmental Quality, this bill has no state expenditure impact.

The bill provides for a civil penalty for any person who violates the provisions of this legislation. Section 62.1-44.32, Code of Virginia, provides for the deposit of such civil penalties to the Virginia Environmental Emergency Response Fund, or to the treasury of the locality in which the violation occurs.
