Summary: Prohibits the governing bodies of any public institution of higher education from adopting or enforcing any rule, regulation, or policy governing the carrying of a concealed handgun on property owned by the institution by a full-time faculty member who possesses a valid Virginia concealed handgun permit. The bill also provides that any rule, regulation, or policy adopted prior to July 1, 2015, prohibiting a full-time faculty member in possession of a valid Virginia concealed handgun permit from carrying a concealed handgun on the property of or in buildings owned by the institution, is invalid.
