**3. Committee:** Education

**4. Title:** Prohibits public higher education governing bodies from adopting policies or rules restricting full-time faculty from carrying concealed handguns.

**5. Summary:** Prohibits the governing bodies of any public institution of higher education from adopting or enforcing any rule, regulation, or policy governing the carrying of a concealed handgun on property owned by the institution by a full-time faculty member who possesses a valid Virginia concealed handgun permit. The bill also provides that any rule, regulation, or policy adopted prior to July 1, 2015, prohibiting a full-time faculty member in possession of a valid Virginia concealed handgun permit from carrying a concealed handgun on the property of or in buildings owned by the institution, is invalid.

**7. No Fiscal Impact:** Preliminary. See item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the state as a result of this legislation.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** All public institutions of higher education in Virginia.

**10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** No.

**11. Other Comments:** This legislation is similar to HB 1389, except that HB 1389 prohibits the higher education institutions from restricting the carrying of a concealed handgun by any person, while this bill only prohibits the institutions from restricting the carrying of a concealed handgun by full-time faculty.
