**4. Title:** Campaign finance reports; filing schedule.

**5. Summary:** Ends the pre-election reporting period for certain campaign finance reports 12 days before the election and begins the special large contribution reporting period 11 days before the election. This change eliminates an overlap under current law by which certain contributions given on the last day of the pre-election reporting period must be disclosed on both the pre-election report and the special large contribution report.
