**4. Title:** Nurse practitioners can testify as expert witnesses.

**5. Summary:** Allows a nurse practitioner to testify as an expert witness in a court of law on certain matters within the scope of his activities and adds nurse practitioner to the definition of "health care provider" under the medical malpractice statutes.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** FINAL.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill would have no fiscal impact because it updates the Code of Virginia to allow nurse practitioners to testify as an expert witness and adds nurse practitioners to the definition of "health care provider." This bill requires no action from any state agency.
