4. Title: Local and regional adult fatality review teams

5. Summary: Allows for the creation of local or regional adult fatality review teams upon the initiative of any local or regional law-enforcement agency, department of social services, emergency medical services agency, attorney for the Commonwealth's office, or community services board. The bill provides that such teams may be established for the purpose of conducting contemporaneous reviews of local adult deaths in order to develop interventions and strategies for prevention specific to the locality or region.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The bill does seek an exemption from the Administrative Process Act; however doing so does not create a fiscal impact.
