4. Title: Special identification cards

5. Summary: This bill allows special identification cards issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to indicate, when requested by the applicant or his parent or guardian and upon presentation of a statement signed by a licensed physician, that the applicant (i) is an insulin-dependent diabetic, (ii) is hearing or speech impaired, or (iii) has an intellectual disability, as defined in § 37.2-100, or autism spectrum disorder, as defined in § 38.2-3418.17.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Motor Vehicles, no fiscal impact is anticipated from this proposal.
