Excludes any automated teller machine, cash-dispensing machine, or similar electronic or computer terminal from the definition of a credit union's service facility. By excluding such items from the scope of what constitutes a credit union service facility, the measure removes the requirement that their locations be approved by the State Corporation Commission. Removes the requirement that in-state banks provide notice to, and receive approval from the State Corporation Commission before establishing automated teller machines, and also removes the requirement that out-of-state banks provide a copy of notice and/or application to its home state regulator to the State Corporation Commission.
