**4. Title:** Standards of Learning; Board of Education prohibited from adopting revisions that implement Common Core State Standards.

**5. Summary:** The bill would prohibit the Board of Education from replacing the Standards of Learning with the Common Core State Standards without prior statutory approval from the General Assembly. The bill states that its provisions shall not be construed to prevent the Board of Education from continuing or creating an educational standard or assessment that is coincidentally included in the standards referred to as the Common Core State Standards
