4. Title: Requirements for home instruction of children; year-end assessments, cutoff date.

5. Summary: The bill would provide that parents of a child who begins home instruction on or after the first day of February would not be required to provide evidence of academic achievement for the current school year. Currently, the Code requires parents to provide evidence of academic achievement by August 1 following the school year in which the child received home instruction.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill would amend the reporting requirements of parents who begin to home-school their children on or after February 1. The bill will not impact state finances.
