5. Summary: The enrolled bill allows the Department of Social Services (DSS) to establish and operate an arrears compromise program pursuant to which it may compromise of child support arrears and interest accrued thereon owed to the Commonwealth for reimbursement of public assistance paid.

Fiscal Implications: Under the provisions of this bill DSS would be allowed to accept offers in compromise of child support arrears and interest owed to the Commonwealth for reimbursement of public assistance paid. The ultimate final impact of this bill is dependent on the program implemented by the department. It is assumed that the department will operate a program that maximizes collections without an adverse impact to the Commonwealth.
