4. Title: Display or distribution of information at firearms shows.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation requires a vendor or exhibitor at firearms shows to display at his booth or table a sign that contains his full legal name, the name and address of the business, if applicable, and his telephone number. The bill also provides that no vendor or exhibitor in the show may advertise that he is not required to obtain criminal history record information for potential customers or any other substantially similar statement.

8. Fiscal Implications Under the proposal, a firearms shows promoter shall ensure compliance with the provisions of this legislation. The bill has no material impact on the Department of State Police.
