Summary: Establishes the Eastern Virginia Groundwater Management Advisory Committee (the Committee) to assist the Stat Water Commission and the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) in developing, revising, and implementing a management strategy for ground water in the Eastern Virginia Groundwater Management Area. The Committee shall develop specific statutory, budgetary, and regulatory recommendations, as necessary, to implement its recommendations. The Committee shall report the results of its examination and related recommendations to the State Water Commission and the Director of the DEQ no later than August 1, 2017. The Director of DEQ shall issue a report responding to the Committee's recommendations to the Governor, the State Water Commission, the Chairman of the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources, the Chairman of the Senate Commission no later than November 1, 2017. The bill has a sunset date of January 1, 2018. The third enactment clause prohibits the issue of draft permits that would require reductions in volumes of ground water withdrawals prior to December 31, 2015.

Fiscal Implications: This bill establishes the Eastern Virginia Groundwater Management Advisory Committee (the Committee) to assist the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) in developing, revising, and implementing a management strategy for ground water. The committee shall be composed of nonlegislative citizen members that shall not receive compensation for their service or reimbursement for expenses. According to DEQ, there could be some expenditure increase due to management of the committee, but any anticipated fiscal impact could be absorbed within existing resources.
