1. Bill Number: HB2056-H1

3. Committee: Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Election administration; lists of registered voters and persons who voted in certain elections.

5. Summary: The legislation, as amended, contains technical amendments to reflect the administrative reorganization of the Department of Elections that took effect July 1, 2014. The bill also requires the local electoral boards to provide to the Department of Elections within 14 days after the election the list of persons who voted, including those who voted provisionally and were determined to be entitled to vote, unless such lists are not available due to a pending recount or election contest. Current law requires the list be submitted within 60 days. The bill requires electoral boards of localities using nonelectronic pollbooks to submit the list of persons who voted to the Department of Elections within seven days after the pollbooks are released from the possession of the clerk of court. The bill also requires any voter who casts a provisional ballot and is determined by the electoral board to have been entitled to vote shall have his name included on the list of persons who voted that is submitted to the Department of Elections pursuant to § 24.2-406, Code of Virginia.

7. No Fiscal Impact

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Elections, as amended, House Bill 2056 would not result in a state fiscal impact.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Elections; electoral boards; and localities.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: Yes. On line 60, after “election”, strike “, unless such lists are not available due to a pending recount or election contest”. This statement is already included on line 58.
