4. Title: Restaurant employees; training in food safety and food allergy awareness and safety.

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Health to include training standards, including training standards for restaurant employees that address food safety and food allergy awareness and safety, in its regulations governing restaurants. The bill also requires the Commissioner of Health to provide written materials on food safety and food allergy awareness and safety for the training of restaurant personnel.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The Department of Health has stated that this bill would not impact operations. The bill may promulgate a change in regulations, but that will not have a fiscal impact on the state.
