3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions

4. Title: Acute psychiatric bed registry; frequency of updating.

5. Summary: This bill requires state facilities, community services boards, behavioral health authorities, and private inpatient psychiatric service providers to (i) update information included in the acute psychiatric bed registry whenever there is a change in bed availability for the facility, board, authority, or provider and (ii) review information included in the acute psychiatric bed registry for accuracy at least once daily.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: None

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill seeks to codify current practice and has been sought by Community Services Boards in order to more concretely establish the definition of “real-time” when updating the acute psychiatric bed registry (PBR). The codification of the requirement to update the PBR on a daily basis as beds become available has no fiscal impact on state programs.
