4. Title: Teacher licensure; career and technical education endorsement.

5. Summary: Currently, teachers seeking an initial license in Virginia with an endorsement in career and technical education must possess an industry certification in the relevant area. The proposed legislation would permit the Board of Education to issue provisional licenses to career and technical education teachers who have not yet attained the industry certification credential.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill would allow career and technical education teachers to receive provisional licenses while they work towards earning the required industry certification. The bill will not impact state finances.
