3. Committee: Education

4. Title: Illegitimate repetition of grade levels; tuition.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would provide that if a school principal determines that the parent of an enrolled student chose for his child to repeat a grade level for an illegitimate, non-educational reason, such student shall not be deemed to reside in the school division and shall be charged tuition for the second year at such grade level.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill would require tuition to be charged to parents of students who repeat a grade level for illegitimate reasons. Any such tuition revenue collected by school divisions is considered a local revenue source.

The bill is not anticipated to impact state finances.
