Summary:** The proposed legislation provides that a court shall order the continuation of child support for any child over the age of 18 who is severely and permanently mentally or physically disabled, provided that the parent from whom support is being sought or received is financially able to provide such support.

Fiscal Implications:** While this proposal could increase the child support enforcement caseload; the Department of Social Services estimates any such increase would be relatively insignificant as the number of cases impacted by this legislation would be small.
