**3. Committee:** Passed Both Houses

**4. Title:** Marine Resources Commission; conveyance of easement and rights of way; Rappahannock River.

**5. Summary:** Authorizes the Virginia Marine Resources Commission to grant an easement and rights-of-way across beds of the Rappahannock River, including a portion of the Baylor Survey Grounds No. 1, to Virginia Electric and Power Company (Dominion Virginia Power) for the construction and maintenance of an overhead electric transmission line across the Rappahannock River in Middlesex and Lancaster Counties, an area containing 8.27 acres. This bill includes an emergency clause.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final. See Item 8 below.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Marine Resources Commission has the authority to convey, based on terms and conditions agreed to by the Governor and Attorney General, easements within the Rappahannock River and the Baylor Survey. The terms and conditions of any conveyance are unknown.

Any fiscal impact that may result will be minimal and can be absorbed within existing resources.
