**4. Title:** DMAS; waiver eligibility criteria; dependents of active duty military

**5. Summary:** The enrolled bill requires the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) to amend eligibility criteria for waivers supporting individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities to allow the dependent of an active duty member of the military who was added to the waiting list for services through such waivers while they were a resident of the Commonwealth to maintain their position on the waiting list following a transfer of the active duty military member to an assignment outside of the Commonwealth, so long as the active duty military member maintains the Commonwealth as his legal residence to which he intends to return following completion of military service.
