4. Title: Movable Soccer Goal Safety Act created.

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Health to promulgate regulations, consistent with the Guidelines for Movable Soccer Goal Safety published by the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, establishing safety standards for anchoring, securing, and counter-weighting movable soccer goals. The bill also prohibits the sale of movable soccer goals that are not tip-resistant beginning July 1, 2016.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate, see item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact on the Commonwealth is indeterminate until regulations are promulgated. As the bill remains silent on the enforcement mechanism to be used to identify and certify movable soccer goals, a fiscal impact cannot be determined. However, the agency believes that a Movable Soccer Goal Safety program would function similarly in size and scope to a current program, Bedding and Upholstery Inspection, and would require \$403,295 annually and five positions to enforce movable soccer goal safety law. Until regulations are promulgated, and the specifics of the act are determined, it is impossible to estimate the fiscal impact on the Commonwealth.
