4. Title: Requires higher education institutions to notify parents of students exhibiting suicidal tendencies.

5. Summary: Requires the governing body of public institutions of higher education to establish policies and procedures requiring the notification of the parent of a dependent student when the institution obtains information outside the mental health treatment setting that such student is exhibiting suicidal tendencies if knowledge of the information is necessary to protect the health or safety of the student or other individuals.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that any administrative efforts required to address the provisions of this legislation can be accommodated within existing resources of the higher education institutions.
