**5. Summary:** Requires the sheriff, superintendent, or Department of Corrections to give notice to any victim as soon as practicable following the transfer of such prisoner. Under current law, such notice must be given at least 15 days prior to the transfer.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact as it changes the notification to after the transfer of a prisoner as opposed to 15 days before such transfer.
