3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: Tobacco Indemnification and Community Revitalization Commission.

5. Summary: This bill expands the purposes for which the Tobacco Indemnification and Community Revitalization Commission can distribute funds to include providing proton therapy telemedicine and scientific research performed at one of the Commonwealth's cancer research and treatment centers in Southside or Southwest Virginia for citizens living in the two regions.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: At this time, the fiscal impact to the Tobacco Indemnification and Community Revitalization Commission is indeterminate. According to the Commission, a fiscal impact will be incurred only to extent that applications are received and approved for grants to these organizations. Currently, the Commission is unable to predict the number of applications that will be received as a result of this legislation.
