**4. Title:** School board clerks; electronic maintenance of records.

**5. Summary:** The proposed legislation would permit the clerk of each school board to keep volumes of meeting minutes and receipt and disbursement records, vouchers, contracts, and other official papers electronically.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** None.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill affects local school boards and does not have a state fiscal impact. Since the bill provides that clerks “may” keep documents electronically, there is no required fiscal impact on local school boards to convert documents or procure systems allowing them to maintain electronic documentation.
